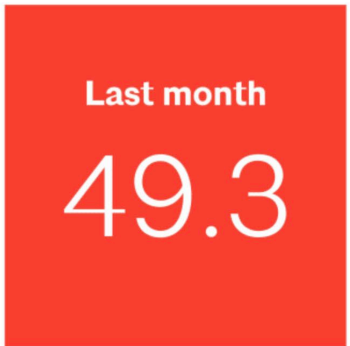
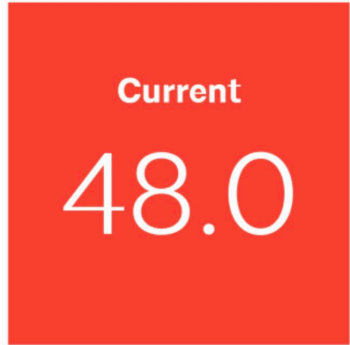
Q2 2023 Economic Outlook Overview

- Economy remains weak; degree of weakness varies considerably by location and industry.
- Pumped up by inflation, construction spending has been strong through first quarter.
- In contrast, architecture firms are seeing softness. Forecast for architecture firms is for flat revenue this year; multifamily residential and commercial sectors projected for similar slowdown.

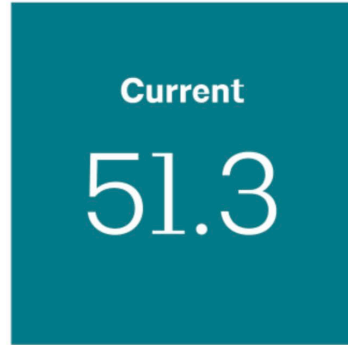

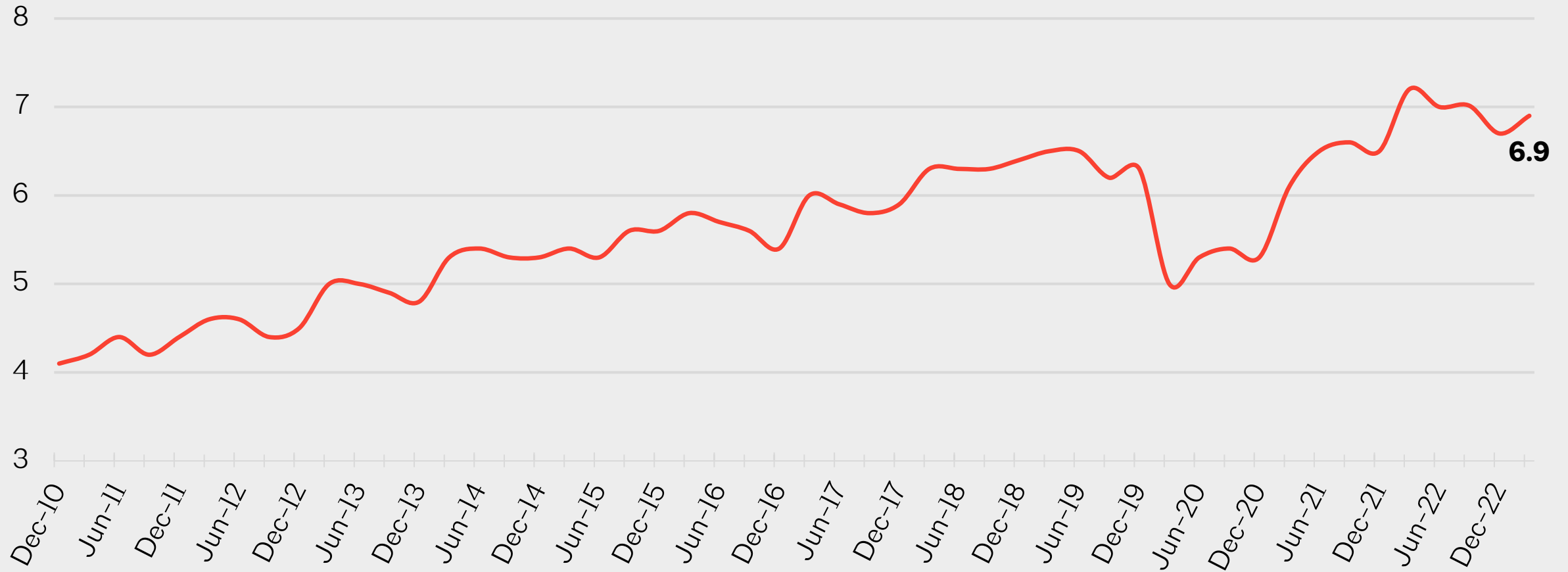
